We are pleased to announce that Dr. Ron Elliott has been chosen as the 2010 SEC Team Physician of the Year. Dr. Elliott has been on staff at the University of Georgia University Health Center since 1985. A native of Macon, he received his BS degree from Georgia Tech and his medical degree from Medical College of Georgia. He completed his Family Medicine residency in the Greenville, South Carolina Hospital system, where he was chief resident. He currently serves as lead physician for the Dr. John “Bud” Robinson Sports Medicine Clinic and has been a team physician for the UGA Athletic Association

since 1988. He served as the head team physician for 18 years and currently serves as the medical director for the nationally accredited undergraduate athletic training education curriculum. Dr. Elliott is a member of the American Academy of Family Practice, the Georgia Academy of Family Practice, and the American College of Sports Medicine. He is past chairman of the Georgia Academy Sports Medicine Committee, a charter member of the American Medical Society for Sports Medicine, and was among the first primary care physicians to receive his National Certification in Sports Medicine.
